

## Script for Two Actors or more

The Narrator has the biggest part here, so you could get your grown ups involved in this if they wanted to join in. If you've only got 2 people: have a Zacchaeus and a Narrator who will read all the other parts too. If there's more of you: first add Jesus, then a crowd, and if there's still more, you could split the Narrator's part into more than one.
